

Indoor Cricket Centre Conditions Of Use

1. **The use of video cameras and photographic equipment, including photo mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the Cricket Centre.**
2. All bookings are to be paid for in advance (min 5 weeks for individual coaching). A booking will not be confirmed until payment and application form have been received and acknowledged.
3. Bookings can be paid for by credit/debit card over the telephone but will not be confirmed until application forms have been received and acknowledged.
4. We reserve the right to cancel coaching sessions and club nets should payment not be received on or before the requested date.
5. Bookings are accepted only on the understanding that ECCC reserves the right to cancel the booking should the minimum number of attendees not be fulfilled. ECCC or ECCB bookings will always take priority. Although all care is taken to avoid booking conflicts and cancellations, due to the nature of professional sport this is not always possible.
6. Appropriate non-marking footwear is to be worn at all times. High ridged studs or spikes are not allowed.
7. Conventional whites are to be worn at all times. Coloured tracksuits are not permitted.
8. Users are expected to supply their own equipment, including balls.
9. A maximum of 6 players per lane (safety requirement).
10. ECCC will strictly adhere to the ECB directive on the use of helmets. These regulations will also apply during indoor league competitions.
11. Every effort will be made to supply the coach requested but this may not always be possible.
12. Club nets booked for children under 14 years of age (without a Cricket Centre coach), must be supervised by an adult at all times.
13. Attendance at the Cricket Centre does not entitle entry to any other part of the ground and does not guarantee available parking for vehicles.
14. No cricket equipment is to be left in the nets and players must pad up in the changing rooms provided (safety requirement). No responsibility will be accepted for valuables left in the changing rooms. Valuables may be left with the Cricket Centre steward/administrator.
15. Please switch off all mobile phones.
16. We regret that ECCC cannot be held responsible for the loss of property or any injury incurred whilst on the premises.
17. Spectators are forbidden to enter the net area without specific permission (safety requirement). Please use the viewing balcony.
18. We would expect all users to comply with the Essex CCC Health and Safety Policy, which is freely available. Please ask at the office for details.
19. Please familiarise yourselves with all emergency exits prior to use. The emergency assembly point is at the Hayes Close entrance to the ground. Please ask if you are unsure.
